- (1) **Public Hearing Growth Management Plan**
- 1) Public Hearing for proposed Urban Growth Management Plan required by Tennessee Code Annotated, Public Chapter 1101  
Mr. Russ Newman, Office of Planning and Community Development, came forward and presented the proposed plans for Loudon County. He explained there are three categories: 1) Urban Growth Area, 2) Rural Growth Area and 3) Planned Growth Area. The two purposes of this state law are to deal with urban sprawl and annexation.  
Commissioner Jenkins commented on the proposed plan by Lenoir City and public opposition to that plan.  
Mary Anderson came forward and spoke of concerns of the costs to Lenoir City in annexing all the proposed areas and concerns of the attitudes of the Chairman of the Coordinating Committee. Ms. Anderson does not wish to be included in the Urban Growth Area proposed by Lenoir City and does not wish to be annexed by the City of Lenoir City.  
Ed Loy came forward and spoke of concerns of the proposed Planned Growth Area boundaries because of possible increase in cost of development of these areas and property owners in the Rural Growth areas will suffer. He would like to see the Planned Growth Area larger.  
Van Shaver came forward and spoke in support of the alternate proposal for the east boundaries of Lenoir City. He also asked for County Commission support in the protection from the Lenoir City proposed plan.  
Nedra Wilburn came forward with concerns of the possibility of Lenoir City annexing her property.  
Commissioner Park and Commissioner Duff both commented on the proposed plan by Lenoir City and stated that they felt the Urban Growth areas pertaining to the 5<sup>th</sup> District should remain as where the current city limits are now.  
Pat Hunter came forward and spoke of concerns of the Lenoir City proposed plan and of possible annexation by Lenoir City. Mr. and Mrs. Pat Hunter are in opposition of being in the Urban Growth Area of the Urban Growth Plan and are in opposition of being annexed by the city of Lenoir City.  
Hank McGhee came forward and spoke of concerns of the Greenback city proposed plan and the concern of providing service to these areas, if annexed, when there are no existing services. He requested the Urban Growth area remain as where the city limits are now.  
Commissioner Randolph spoke of concerns of the proposed plan by the City of Loudon and the decrease in tax revenues for the county.  
Donnie Lawson came forward and spoke of concerns of the proposed plan by Lenoir City and how some properties are excluded from the growth areas.

**County Executive George Miller** asked Mr. Russ Newman to give an update on the Hwy. 70/Hickory Creek Road Project. Mr. Newman reported that the county has been approved for a Highway Safety Grant of \$50,000 for this project. The engineering fees for the entire are estimated at \$228,000. There is no money available needed to proceed with this project. In conversations Mr. Newman has had with the Regional Administrator of TDOT, the administrator had indicated a possible commitment of discretionary funding, if available in this year's budget, which would provide funding to do the Hwy.70 portion of the project. Since that time these funds have been frozen. Mr. Newman suggested that if these discretionary funds do not become available, the county proceed with the Hickory Creek Rd alignment. A conceptual design for this project is available at the Planning Office.

**SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED,**

by the Board of County Commissioners of London County, Tennessee assembled in session on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1999, that in the amounts hereafter set out are hereby appropriated for the purpose of meeting the expenses of the various funds, departments, institutions, offices and agencies of London County ,Tennessee for the capital outlay, and for meeting the payment of principal and interest on the County/s debt maturing during the year beginning July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2000, according to the following schedules

**SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that there are also hereby appropriated certain portions of the commissions and fees for collecting taxes and licenses and for administering other funds with the Trustee, County Clerk, Circuit Court Clerk, Clerk and Master, Register and Sheriff and their officially authorized deputies and assistants may severally be entitled to receive under State Laws heretofore or hereafter enacted expenditures out of commissions and/or fees collected by the Trustee, County Clerk, Circuit Court Clerk, Clerk and Master, Register and the Sheriff, may be made for such purposes and in such amount as may be authorized by existing law or by valid order of any court having power to make such appropriations. Any excess commissions and/or fees collected over and above the expenditures duly and conclusively authorized shall be paid over to the Trustee and converted in to the General Fund as provided by law.

**BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED**, that if any fee officials, as enumerated in Section 8-22-101, T.C.A. operated under provisions of Section 8-22-104. T.C.A. provisions of the preceding paragraph shall not apply to those particular officials.

**SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, *that any amendments to the budget shall be approved as provided in Section 5-9-407, T.C.A.*

One Copy of each amendment shall be filed with the County Clerk, one copy with the Chairman of the Budget Committee and one copy with each divisional or

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department head concerned authorizing transfer from one fund to another, but shall apply solely to transfers from one fund to another.

**SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RECOLVED**, that any appropriations made by this resolution which cover the same purpose for which specific appropriations is made by statute, is made in lieu of but not in addition to said statutory appropriations. The salary wages, or remuneration of each officer, employee, or agent of the County shall not be in excess of the amount authorized by existing law or as set for in the estimated of expenditures which accompanies this resolution. Provided, however, that appropriations for such salaries, wages or other remuneration hereby authorized shall in no case be construed as permitting expenditures for an office, agency, institution, division or department of the County. Such appropriation shall constitute the limit to the expenditures of any office agency, institution, division or department for the year ending June 30, 1999. The aggregate expenditures for any item of appropriation shall in no instance be more than the amount herein appropriated for such item.

**SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that any resolution which may hereafter be presented to the Board of County Commission providing for appropriations in addition to those made by the Budget Appropriation resolution shall specifically provide sufficient revenue or other funds, actually to be provided during the year in which the expenditure is to be made, to meet such additional appropriation. Said appropriating resolution shall be submitted to and approved by the State Director of Local Finance after its adoption as provided by Section 9-21-403, T.C.A.

**SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the County Executive and the County Clerk are hereby authorized to borrow money on revenue anticipate notes, provided such notes are first approved by the director of Local Finance, to pay for the expenses herein authorized until the taxes and other revenue for the year 1999-2000 have been collected. The proceeds of loans for each individual fund shall not exceed 60% of the appropriation of each individual fund and shall be used only to pay expenses and other requirements of the fund for which the loan is made. The loan shall be paid out of revenue from the fund for which the money is borrowed. The notes evidencing the loans authorized under this section shall be issued under the applicable section of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated. Said notes shall be signed by the County Executive and countersigned by the County Clerk and shall mature and be paid in full without renewal not later than June 30, 2000.

**SECTION 7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the delinquent county property taxes for the year 1998 and prior years and the interest and penalty hereon collected during the Year ending June 30, 1998 shall be apportioned to the various county funds according to the subdivision of the tax levy for the year 1998. The Clerk and Master and the Trustee are hereby authorized and directed to make such apportionment accordingly.

**SECTION 8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all unencumbered balances of appropriations remaining at the end of the year shall lapse, and be of no further effect at the end of the year June 30, 2000.

**SECTION 9. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that any resolution or part of a resolution which has heretofore been passed by the Board of County Commission which is in conflict with any provision in this resolution be and the same is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 10. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the 3-cent (three-cent) gasoline tax be pledged for repayment of outstanding bonds and notes issued for capital and road improvement by the County Highway Department.

**SECTION 11. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the portion of BEP (Better Education Program) State Funding be pledged for the repayment of outstanding capital outlay notes issued for school improvements.

**SECTION 12. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that 50% of the Hotel/Motel Tax collections be designated for the promotion of countywide tourism; 25% be designated to the Highway Fund for operational purposes; and 25% remain the County General Fund.

**SECTION 13. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all monies received from a Severance Tax be placed in the Highway Fund for operational purposes.

**SECTION 14. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Recycling and Convenience Center's operational expenses shall be supported by transfers of revenue from the County General Fund # 101-55720.

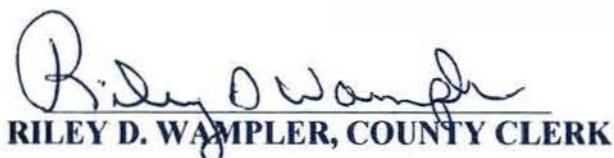

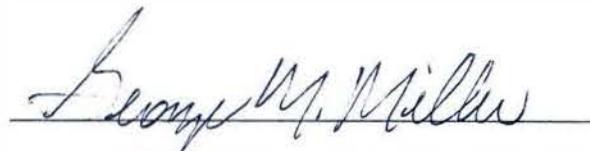

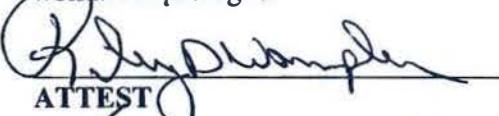
**WHEREAS**, the Loudon County Regional Planning Commission unanimously denied this request to rezone the property; and

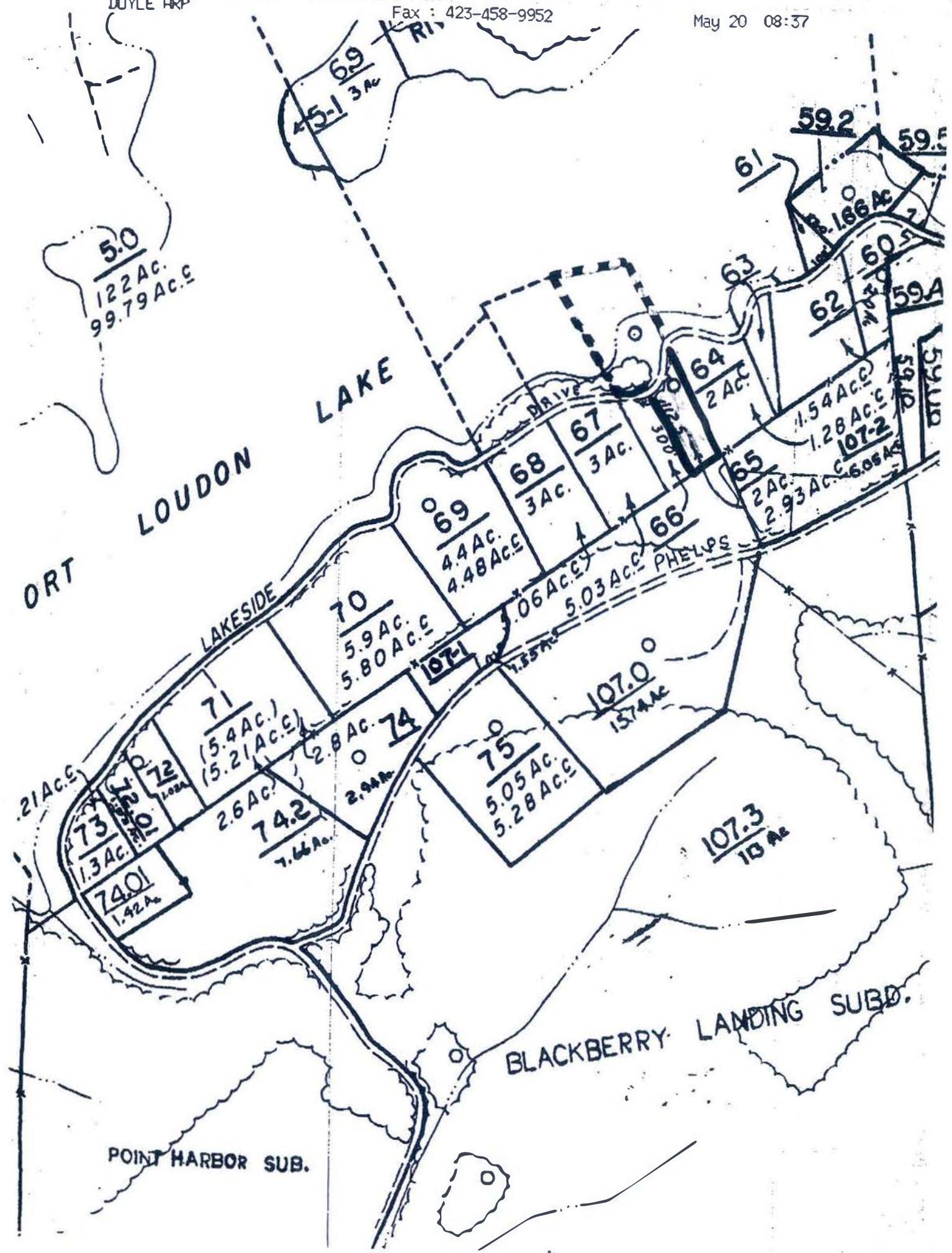
