Dear Mayor Arp:

As we discussed on my recent visit the Red Cross has experienced reduced financial support in Loudon County. Last year our organization assisted 58 families in time of need and incurred over \$9,000 in direct expense to provide relief and services to those families. Individual donations are less than last year and the Loudon County United Way has also reduced our allocation from the previous year.

The Red Cross will always be there to help and it is our goal to always be able to provide adequate assistance to those in need, when it is needed. As a result of reduced income we have reviewed our expense structure in Loudon County. Last year our only paid employee left the Red Cross and, as a cost-savings measure, was not replaced. Today, we provide our services and programs through an active corps of volunteers. Our physical presence in Loudon County is our chapter house located at 9010 Highway 11W, Lenoir City. We rent this facility from Loudon County at a very favorable term of \$3,000 annually. Our additional occupancy expenses to maintain this location are \$2500.

We can best serve our communities with a physical presence in that county. However, it is our responsibility to our clients and our mission to always maintain available resources to provide relief assistance when needed.

We are requesting consideration be given to other options so we may avoid having to exit our physical presence in Loudon County. There are actions we can take to reduce our other occupancy expenses and we are requesting to be allowed to remain in the property with no rent payment. The house is in an undesirable location for any other use, and it's beneficial for County government to have an active Red Cross. Should this option not be approved, we ask for consideration to relocate to another location where we would be able to maintain a presence at minimal occupancy expenses.

As you indicated this request will require review by the County Finance Committee and we look forward to a timely response following that review.
