(22) Comments: Non-Agenda Items **Chairman Bledsoe** asked that any visitor wishing to address the Commission regarding items not on the Agenda come forward.

Richard Truit came forward to express his concern about comments he said **Commissioner Yarbrough** had made at a recent Budget Committee meeting regarding possible tax proposals, mentioning several options. He commented that she never mentioned supporting tax increases when she was campaigning.

Pat Hunter spoke to comment that the recently revamped Loudon County Government Website no longer listed all the contact information for each of the County Commissioners and requested that this be made available.

Commissioner Meers requested that the Mayor contact the Loudon County E-911 Board to request they provide an update on their status to the Commission. He stated that when the agreement between the County and the LCECD, establishing them as a separate entity, was passed in December 2009 the E-911 Representatives agreed to present these updates quarterly and, to date, none have been provided. **Commissioner Miller** supported this request and suggested the Representatives come to a Commission Workshop Meeting to provide this information. **Mayor Herron** agreed to contact them.

Commissioner Miller spoke in agreement with the previous request made by Ms. Hunter stating that he wasn't aware that all the Commissioner's information was not currently on the website and he encouraged the people of the county to feel welcome to contact him. His sentiment was echoed by the other Commissioners.

Commissioner Yarbrough spoke in response to Mr. Truitt's comments above stating that her remarks made in the Budget Committee meeting were part of a discussion of "possible" sources of income for the county and not a proposal for such taxes.
