Intent:

To create a financial mechanism that accrues sufficient closure/postclosure funds throughout the life of the Matlock Bend Landfill

To close portions of the landfill as part of Santek's contractual obligations

Mechanism:

Establish a joint, interest-bearing account in which a dollar amount per ton will be deposited solely for the purpose of funding closure and post-closure care. The account will be established in conjunction with Santek securing a major permit modification for a vertical and horizontal expansion of the landfill.

Create a Control Agreement to perfect the Commission's security interest in the Financial Assurance Account and to protect funds as they're deposited into the account.

Increase the closure/post-closure dollar amount to \$1.04 per ton, and review and adjust the amount annually based on various factors including:

- Remaining Airspace & Density Factor
- Existing Closure/Post-closure Reserves
- Anticipated Closure/Post-closure Liabilities (including expansion area)
- TDEC Inflation Factor
- Remaining Closure/Post-closure Liabilities

Amend Section 8 of the Landfill Management Agreement to reflect a phased closure approach as well as the establishment of the Financial Assurance Account and Control Agreement.

Determine the amount to be deposited into the Financial Assurance Account.

Comment No. 1 (Loudon County Commissioner). Thanks for the work you are doing. Great preplanning, excellent meeting. Informative

Comment No. 2 (Loudon County Commissioner). Good program and presenters. Thank you!

Comment No. 3 (Loudon County Commissioner). Today: Landfills are in surplus; tipping fees are low. Future: Based on experience, landfill capacities will be short & tipping fees will be very high. Thus, my answer to Question 10: shut down when fees low/restart when fees are high. Would like to know cost of mothballing and temporary closure. Also would like to see economics (cash flows, costs, etc.) for the most promising options.

- Comment No. 4 (Lenoir/Loudon City Council Member). Landfill tipping fees must be lowered by 10-20% at the very least, by some method and soon.
- Comment No. 5 (Lenoir/Loudon City Council Member). I am opposed to hauling our trash out of county if we can save money and save our space for future operations. However, I would want to look at the viability of each option.
- Comment No. 6 (Other governmental representative). If a transfer station is initiated perhaps we would also want a C&D cell left there.
- Comment No. 7 (Other government representative). Keep government units informed as you progress not seeking the concurrence of the government bodies.
- Comment No. 8 (Other government representative). Consider long range Class IV needs in light of expected construction in the county.
- Comment No. 9 (Other government representative). Need rate reduction for the taxpayer. However, we should look for longevity in our site. I am disappointed in the cost of our contract with the current operator.

Mayor Herron:

I am the President of the Warriors Chase Homeowners Association and reside at 228 Blackfoot Way, Lenoir City, TN 37772. Warriors Chase is comprised of 40 homes and is located 1.1 mile west of Watt Road off of Route 70. Our Homeowners Association was formed in the past year when the subdivision developer turned over control to the homeowners.

As you are aware, the top coat of asphalt was never placed on our subdivision streets. The builder has indicated that he did not have sufficient funds to complete the paving.

I believe that Loudon County should complete the paving in our subdivision. As you know, when a developer wishes to build a subdivision he must submit plans and gain approval from the county. Plans will not be approved unless they meet minimum standards established by the county. The developer must also provide a performance bond which ensures that sufficient funds are available to complete the project. The performance bond should not be released until inspections of the project determine that all work is complete and in full conformance to the plans and County codes and standards.

In 2004 Mr. Don Palmer (current Road Commissioner) signed off on the Platt signifying that all work was complete and in conformance to County standards allowing the performance bond to be released. The sign off and release of the bond was done even though the final layer of asphalt had not been applied.

At the suggestion of your staff, I have met with Mr. Russ Newman in Planning and Codes Enforcement. While sympathetic, Mr. Newman indicated that there was nothing he could do.

I have also talked with Mr. Eddie Simpson, Road Commissioner, who indicated that he could not provide assistance unless the subdivision streets were taken over by the County. Mr. Simpson indicated that he would try to attend the July 14th Loudon County Commission workshop session and bring this issue before the Commission.

I am requesting that this issue be brought before the Loudon County Commission. The homeowners in Warriors Chase should not be required to pay for the paving of their streets because the developer ran out of funds and the County failed to follow procedures that would have ensured completion.

It is my understanding that this situation has occurred in the past with other developments and the County assumed responsibility for completion.

I will be happy to attend the Workshop meeting on July 14th and answer any questions the Commission may have.
