It was included in the motion that said property should be bought subject to any and all required state approvals and that the site be architecturally and engineeringly approved for the purpose for which it is purchased. After additional discussion a call for the question was had with a roll-call vote. The vote is as follows: Blair, yes; Bledsoe, yes; Conner, no; Foster, passing; Hudson, yes; Hartsook, no; Williams, yes; Hamilton, yes; and Duckworth, yes.

Judge Russell declared that the motion had passed.
