 $\underline{\text{NOW}}$, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the County Legislative Body of Loudon County, Tennessee as follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of the resolution adopted on September 8, 1980 and referred to in the preamble hereto is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of providing funds for Loudon County's matching share of the purchase of land, pursuant to authority granted by Section 5-10-501 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, as amended, there shall be issued the negotiable notes of said county in the principal amount of \$576,500. Said notes shall be designated "Capital Outlay Notes", shall be dated January 15, 1981, or from the date the notes are executed, shall be in such denomination as may be agreed upon by the County Judge and the purchaser, shall be numbered serially beginning with the Number 1 and shall be callable on January 15, 1983 or any interest payment date thereafter at par and accrued interest to the date of redemption.
