REPORT FROM COMMITTEE
ON SCHOOL BUILDING PROGRAM

The County Commission of Loudon County and the Loudon County School Board meeting in joint session heard a report from the chairman of the committee designated to recommer what course of action the Court should take in funding replacement space for the old Loudon Grammer School.

The Chairman, Mr. John Newman, reported that the committee was unable to agree on a recommendation.

Commissioner Luttrell moved that the Court authorize spending \$1,800,000 (One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars) to build a new school. This motion died for lack of a second.

Commissioner Luttrell moved that the Court authorize the expenditure of \$1,400,000 (One Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars) for renovations and additions to the old Jr. High School on River Road. This motion was seconded by Commissioner John Newman.

Considerable discussion was had on this motion by members of the County Commission, Loudon County School Board Members, Mr. Headles Gary Kimsey, Judge Russell and others. At this point, the Court recessed and remained in recess for a period of time. Upon returning from recess Commissioner Luttrell, with the permission of Commissioner Newman, who had seconded the motion withdrew his motion to fund renovation for \$1,400,000 (One Million Four Hundred Thousand dollars).

Commissioner Newman moved that \$1,200,000 (One Million Two hundred thousand dollars) be authorized and provided for the removation of the old Jr. High School. Commissioner Jim Blair seconded with the following roll-Call Vote.
