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A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
COUNTY TO ESTABLISH THE INTEREST RATE ON
DELINQUENT REAL PROPERTY TAXES IN _____ COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-1105 provides that interest shall be collected on delinquent real property taxes but fails to establish the rate of interest to be collected, and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Tennessee in Article 11, Section 7 provides that where the General Assembly fails to set the rate of interest on certain transactions, then the interest rate shall not exceed ten percent (10%).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of _____ County, meeting in _____ session on this _____ day of _____, 19 _____, that:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-1105, interest shall be collected on delinquent property taxes in _____ County at a rate of _____ percent (%) per annum. This rate of interest shall be collected on all real property taxes which became delinquent on or after June 1, 1982

SECTION 2. The County Trustee shall cause this interest rate to be noted along with the penalty established in T.C.A. § 67-1105 on all notices of delinquent real property taxes.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that a true copy of this Resolution be spread upon the Commission record of this date.

SUBJECT: GENERAL REPORT OF THE LOUDON COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING
COMMISSION

The Loudon County Regional Planning Commission met on
April 15, 1982 to consider and recommend the following:

- 1) Recommended that property on Highway 11, Map 12, Parcel 99 be rezoned from R-1, Single Family Residential to C-2, General Commercial.
- 2) Recommended that property on Hotchkiss Valley Road, Map 28, Parcel 43.6 be rezoned from A-1, Agriculture Forestry to C-2, General Commercial.
- 3) Recommended that property on Highway 70, Map 11, Parcel 135.4 be denied rezoning from R-1, Single Family Residential to C-1, Rural Center
- 4) Commission heard a presentation by staff dealing with sliding scale road standards for subdivision developments and discussed same.
- 5) Commission discussed several alternative methods toward regulating mobile home parks.
- 6) Commission reviewed data on existing county office facilities pertaining to space allotment and proposed needs.


