

RESOLUTION FIXING THE TAX LEVY IN LOUDON  
COUNTY, TENNESSEE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
BEGINNING JULY 1, 1984

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED, by the Loudon County Board of Commissioners of Loudon County, Tennessee assembled in special called session on the 5th day of September 1984, that the combined property tax rate for Loudon County, Tennessee for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1984, shall be \$2.65 on each \$100.00 of taxable property within the boundaries of the City of Lenoir City and \$2.90 on each of the \$100.00 of taxable property in Loudon City, Philadelphia, Greenback and rural Loudon County, which levy is to provide revenue for each of the following funds and otherwise conform to the following levies:
