**WHEREAS,** the Loudon County Commission, in accordance with Chapter Four, section 13-7-105 of the Tennessee Code Annotated may from time to time, amend the number, shape, boundary, area, or any regulation of or within any district or districts, or any other provision of any zoning resolution, and

**WHEREAS,** the Loudon County Regional Planning Commission has forwarded its recommendation regarding the amendment to the Zoning Resolution of Loudon County, Tennessee, and the necessary public hearing called for and held, and

**WHEREAS,** certain expenses are incurred as part of enforcing the county's land use provisions which are established by the community to guide future development, and

**WHEREAS,** during the last thirteen years the county has adopted regulations pertaining to landscaping, drainage control and regulations to protect the public from obnoxious and unsafe use of property, and

**WHEREAS,** increased community standards on development have expanded the need for additional staff within the Building Commissioner's Office in order to enforce the provisions and provide efficient and responsible service to the general public, and

**WHEREAS,** the issuance of building permits between 1986 and 1993 has increased by 45 percent within the unincorporated areas of Loudon County.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Loudon County Commission that the Zoning Resolution of Loudon County, Tennessee, Article 7, ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT, Section 7.030. Building Permits be amended as follows:

3. Utility / warehousing - .05 per square foot of floor space

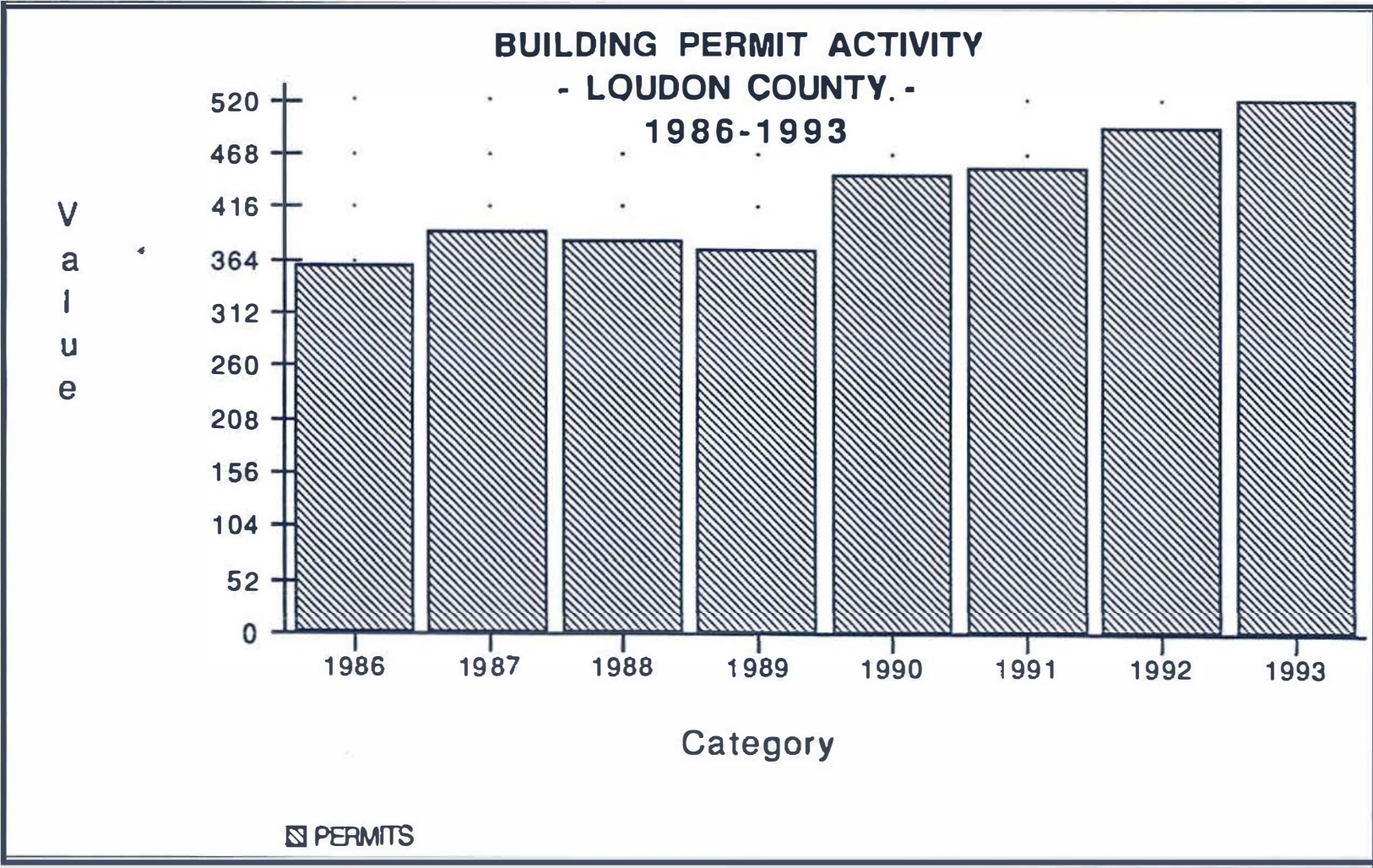
