





LOUDON COUNTY, TENNESSEE
RESOLUTION RESCINDING MINERAL SEVERANCE TAX

WHEREAS, Loudon County had not previously adopted a Mineral Severance Tax; and

WHEREAS, Loudon County adopted, by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote, the Mineral Severance Tax on November 6, 1995, to be imposed on businesses severing minerals from the earth.

WHEREAS, Loudon County Commission, meeting in regular session, on January 8, 1996, resolved by a 2/3 majority vote to rescind the Mineral Severance Tax passed on the above date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Loudon County Commission:

Section 1: Under section 67-7-201, c, Tennessee Code Annotated, any county legislative body which has authorized this tax is further authorized to repeal such tax by adopting a resolution.

Section 2: The tax to be levied shall cease to be imposed at one minute past midnight (12:01 a.m.), on the first day of February, 1996.

Section 3: As referenced, under section 67-7-201(c), for the purposes of repeal, this tax shall have no effect on tax liabilities which occurred prior to the effective date of repeal, or collection actions on such taxes subsequent to the date of repeal; However, Loudon County Commission respectfully requests that our only industry currently mining minerals, Greenback Crushed Stone, be exempted from any taxes levied during the applicable time period.





NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Loudon County Commission that the Zoning Map of Loudon County, Tennessee be amended as follows:

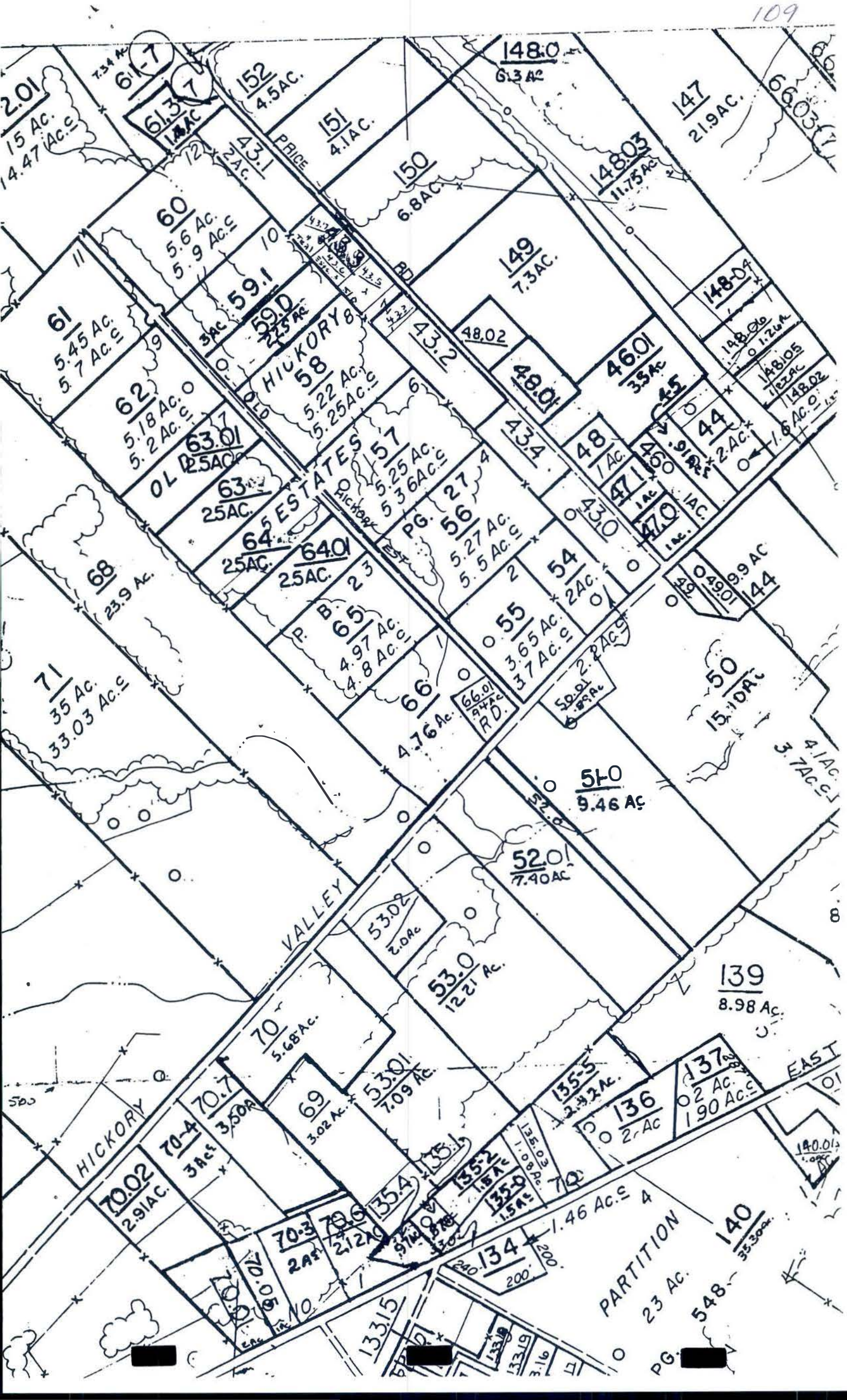
