## RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO ASSIST EATONWOOD SUBDIVISION AREA IN OBTAINING PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER FACILITIES

WHEREAS, for many years the Eatonwood Subdivision (Eatonwood), in the Eaton Crossroads community, has had a serious public health and safety problem in the process of developing all of the lots in the subdivision because the type of soil does not allow percolation and usage of septic tanks as a satisfactory sanitary waste disposal alternative; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that it is possible through the use of a county public utility authority, in coordination with the Lenoir City Utilities Board (LCUB), to provide 69 lots, and 31 houses in the subdivision, plus possible adjoining properties, with a solution to the problem of inadequate sewage disposal, by means of the construction of a sanitary sewer system, which will allow the homes that are already constructed there to retain their value, and allow the other lots in the subdivision to be developed and maintain a reasonable value; and

WHEREAS, it is understood LCUB has requested an indication from the Loudon County Commission (County) as to County's intent in being willing to issue, co-issue, or guarantee, as necessary, bonds to enable the construction of new sanitary sewer lines to and through the Eatonwood Subdivision area; and

WHEREAS, the Loudon County Commission is willing to support this endeavor to assist a community that is in distress in the county, provided that the financial burden (including all related expenses) of correcting the situation can be reasonably assured to be paid by the properties that will benefit by the construction of this system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Loudon County Commission, in regular session assembled this 9th day of September, 1996, that it hereby declares its intent to be willing to issue or guarantee the bonds necessary to raise the funds to provide a sanitary sewer system to the Eatonwood Subdivision area, subject to the approval of the Lenoir City Utilities Board allowing the connection in with its sewer system, and subject to the bonds for the construction cost, including the necessary administrative, legal and consulting expenses, being paid by revenue coming from the property in the community being benefited.




