SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Commission of Loudon County convened in a special called session in Loudon, Tennessee on the 17th day of December 2001.

The meeting was called to order by the **Honorable Roy Bledsoe**.

Sheriff Tim Guider opened Court, led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, and gave the invocation.

Present and presiding were the following Commissioners: **Thomas, Maples, Bledsoe, Masingo, Duff, Park, Jenkins and Harold: (8)**

Thereupon **Chairman Bledsoe** announced the presence of a quorum. Also present were the **Honorable George Miller**, County Executive, and **Harvey Sproul**, County Attorney.

The following items were discussed:

1) Consideration of awarding contract for Jail and Justice Center construction and renovation

Construction Committee Chairman, **Commissioner Park** and Purchasing Agent, **Howard Luttrell**, gave report on Construction Committee's evaluation procedure and recommendation. Construction Committee recommended contract be awarded to Webb Construction with cost not to exceed \$3,270,000. A motion was made by **Commissioner Park** with a second by **Commissioner Jenkins** to accept the recommendation of the Construction Committee and award the contract to Webb Construction.

Upon roll call vote the following commissioners voted Aye: **Thomas, Maples, Jenkins, Masingo, Bledsoe, Duff, Park and Harold: (8)**.

The following commissioner voted Nay: **(0)**.

Thereupon the chairman announced the motion **Passed. (8-0)**

2) Consideration of releasing building permit moratorium on Abbott Crossing Development

A motion was made by **Commissioner Duff** with a second by **Commissioner Park** to lift restraining order on Abbott Crossing Development and allow development to continue.

Upon voice vote the motion passed **unanimously**.

3) Update from County Attorney on pending litigation

Loudon County Attorney, **Harvey Sproul**, notified commissioners of pending litigations:

- a) William Doug Lawrence vs. Loudon County
- b) Tennessee Wastemovers vs. Loudon County Commission

Attorney Sproul noted that he is preparing a report for the state auditors on pending litigation and status.

Attorney Sproul also reminded commission of public notice criteria for filling vacancy of 1st district Commissioner.

A **Motion** being duly made and seconded, the December 17, 2001 special called meeting stood adjourned at 6:27 p.m.
