A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO SUPPORT THE ABANDONMENT OF CERTAIN RIGHT OF WAY ON HIGHWAY 11 IN THE CITY OF LOUDON ASSISTING IN THE REDEVELOPMENT OF THE HISTORIC ORME WILLSON WAREHOUSE

Whereas, the Tennessee Department of Transportation is completing the construction of a new bridge over the Tennessee River in Loudon and demolition of the previous 1920's era steel bridge; and

Whereas, additional right of way was purchased by the State of Tennessee on the downstream side in order to construct a parallel bridge; and

Whereas, the Orme Wilson Warehouse, a structure listed on the National Register of Historic Places, encroaches the existing Hwy.11 right of way; and

Whereas, redevelopment of the Orme Wilson Warehouse is jeopardized by the encroachment since it restricts clear title to the property.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Loudon County Commission authorizes the County Mayor to transmit a letter to the Tennessee Department of Transportation supporting the abandonment of right of way and acceptable conveyance of use through the Department's Excess Property Disposal guidelines that would allow clear title to the aforementioned property.

A Resolution Authorizing The TASS Board of Directors To Sell Their Present Offices And Continue Plans For Building A New Facility

Whereas, for many years the Tellico Area Service System (TASS) offices and board room was located in the water treatment plant building; and

Whereas, the current office and board room are located in an old bank building located on Highway 411; and

Whereas, this facility does not provide adequate accessibility under ADA compliance regulations to the board meeting room; and

Whereas, due to the significant growth of TASS (currently 2,926 residential and over 225 commercial and industrial customers) space is limited for daily operations; and

Whereas, the TASS Board of Directors felt it desirable and necessary to work toward the construction of a new office/multi-use building that will allow for additional space and be handicap accessible; and

Whereas, TVA has given TASS a perpetual lease agreement for the use of approximately five (5) acres located at the southwest corner of US Highway 411 and Clearview Road; and

Whereas, in accordance with the TASS Interlocal Agreement, the TASS Board of Directors requests approval from the counties of Loudon and Monroe to sell the present office building and construct the proposed new office building on newly obtained property, with the cost to be paid from available funds.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Loudon County Commission, meeting in regular session this 13th day of September, 2004, authorizes the TASS Board of Directors to sell their present offices and continue plans for building a new facility.
