A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE OF TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO HONOR THE 20% MATCH FROM LOUDON COUNTY, TENNESSEE FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT SHAW FERRY ROAD AND U.S HWY 11

Whereas, the Loudon County Commission passes a resolution February 07, 2005 urging the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation to appropriate funding for safety improvements at the intersection of Shaw Ferry Road and US Highway 11; and

Whereas, as stated in that resolution, this is a high traffic intersection in a growth area of the county and its use and safety needs have increased dramatically; and

Whereas, the intersection of Shaw Ferry Road and US Highway 11 has been the scene of frequent accidents for several years, including two (2) recent fatalities; and

Whereas, a recent engineering study of the intersection estimated the cost of the project to be \$725,000; and

Whereas, after meeting with State of Tennessee Department of Transportation Commissioner Gerald Nicely, it was understood that additional funding may be available for this project, upon commitment of a 20% match by Loudon County, Tennessee; and

Whereas, the Loudon County Commission passes a resolution on May 2, 2005, committing sufficient funds for a 20% match for the purpose of improving the intersection of Shaw Ferry Road and US Highway 11; and

Whereas, this is thus not a request for a new appropriation of county monies, but rather an urging of the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation to honor Loudon County's prior commitment of a 20% match; and

Whereas, the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation has yet to commence the making of safety improvements at the intersection of Shaw Ferry Road and US Highway 11; and

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the Loudon County Commission meeting in regular session, assembled this 7th day of April, 2008, that Loudon County, Tennessee does hereby request that the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation honor Loudon County's commitment to a 20% match of funding for much needed improvements at Shaw Ferry Road and US Highway 11 and that the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation would perform and complete with all due haste such improvements.

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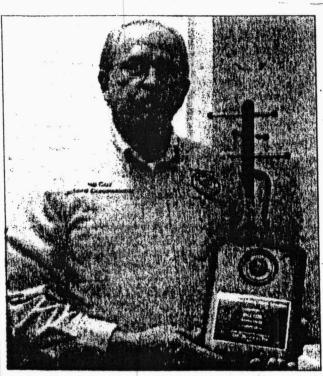
