Chairman Waller opened the floor for items of public concern, the following spoke:

Richard Anklin Of Tellico Village- Regarding the C2 and C4 Cells being closed at Matlock Bend Landfill.

Attorneys Report: Regarding concerns on the Jackson Law and phase 1 update.

MOTION: Chairman Waller asked for a regarding commission pay to be lowered to \$75.00. Mr. Henry Cullen made a motion to approve, and Mr. David Hall seconded the motion.

MOTION: Chairman Mr. Waller asked for approval for reimbursements, office supplies, stipends, legal and misc. Ms. Pat Hunter made a motion to approve, and Mr. David Hall seconded the motion.

Ms. Bobich presented the cash activity report for the month of February. Ms. Bobich also presented the commission with the operations report as outlined in the packets distributed to the commission.

Results of Operations

LCSWDC shows operating revenue of \$363,076, which represents an increase of \$70,223 from the previous year's operating revenue. At the same time, LCSWDC shows an increase in operating expenses of \$5,737,854 over the previous year's operating expenses. LCSWDC shows a positive change in net position due to lower costs related to Poplar Springs Landfill. The increased utilization of the landfill during the year resulted in a \$221,662 increase to the estimated future liability for closure and post closure costs. This increase to the estimated future liability for closure and post closure costs decreased by \$113,100 from the previous year's increase in estimated costs. As of June 30, 2022, LCSWDC completed its fourteenth full year of operations under its 20-year operations contract that commenced on October 1, 2007 and provides for the turn-key operation of Matlock Bend Landfill by the operator instead of LCSWDC.

The statement of cash flows in the accompanying financial statements is presented using the direct method. This method outlines the sources and uses of cash as it relates to operating income.

Capital Assets

Capital asset levels stayed the same from the prior year. LCSWDC did not purchase capital assets during the year ended June 30, 2022.

Future Events

LCSWDC has engaged in extensive negotiations with the Matlock Bend landfill operator to modify the current operating contract. Over the previous year, LCSWDC and the landfill operator have exchanged multiple drafts of a proposed contract modification. The proposed modifications address the anticipated shortfall of funds for covering the estimated future liability for closure and post-closure costs. Under the current contract, the operator is obligated to perform closure- and post-closure care of all cells in the Matlock Bend landfill which attain final elevation during the contract term. Under the present contract modification proposal, the operator has agreed to perform all closure- and post-closure care for the expanded landfill footprint under a phased closure plan implemented in conjunction with the contract modification. In addition to assuming additional closure and post-closure care obligations, the operator has agreed to provide LCSWDC with a performance bond to satisfy regulatory financial assurance requirements in lien of Loudon County's annual pledge of its assets. We anticipate that the operator will ultimately perform all closure and post-closure care of the landfill during the extended contract term: this change will substantially reduce LCSWDC's long-term liability. presently in the process of being acquired by another entity, pending government approval. LCSWDC will further evaluate the proposed contract modification if and when this acquisition is completed. In the interim, the operator is submitting a phased closure plan for the landfill to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation for approval. When implemented, the operator's phased closure plan should have some bearing on LCSWDC's estimated future liability for closure and post-closure costs.

(continued)

The liabilities were estimated based on information provided by the State of Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation when the corresponding cells of the Landfill were initially permitted. Closure and postclosure costs related to Phase I were recognized by the Commission in prior periods based on Landfill capacity as of the date of each statement of net position. The liability for Phase II/IV represents the estimated cumulative amount of closure and postclosure care costs reported to date based on the use of 97.0% of the estimated capacity of the Landfill for that phase. The Commission will recognize the remaining estimated cost of \$392,247 as the remaining permitted capacity of the Landfill is filled. These amounts are based on what it would cost to perform all closure and postclosure care in 2022. The Commission expects to close Phase II/IV of the Landfill in August of 2030 (assuming 80,000 tons of waste per year). The Commission is seeking a permit modification which would extend the life of the landfill and result in a new phase. Actual costs of closure and postclosure may vary based on inflation, deflation, technology, or applicable laws and regulations.

Loudon County, Tennessee (the County) has entered into a Contracts in Lieu of Performance Bond with the State of Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation for Phase I (dated February 24, 1994) and for Phase II/IV (dated September 1, 1997), which are amended from time to time. In the event the County fails to perform closure and postclosure care requirements pursuant to all applicable laws, statutes, rules and regulations as such laws, rules, statutes and regulations may be amended, the contracts pledge future revenues of the County, disbursed from the State of Tennessee to the County, up to the amount of \$13,380,389 (covering all phases of the Landfill) as of June 30, 2022, for closure and postclosure care.

NOTE H – SUBSEQUENT EVENT

In July 2022, the Commission and Republic modified their contract to extend the term of the contract to December 31, 2027 with automatic extensions up to December 31, 2038. In addition, the amended contract requires.....



Mr. Waller:

As specified in the Second Amendment to the Landfill Operating Agreement, effective July 1, 2023, there will be a contractual landfill disposal price increase to the stakeholders and customers of the Matlock Bend Loudon Landfill. The price increase is based on CPI Water/Sewer/Trash as of May 31. The May 31 CPI data has not been published, however in the interest of providing 30-day notice of the price increase, we are calculating an estimated number of 4.57% for planning purposes.

New disposal pricing will be as follows:

Area Government Users -

\$24.65 per ton (approximate)

Non-Area Government Users -

\$27.18 per ton (approximate)

Additionally, we will be doing calculated price increases to the customers of the Matlock Bend Loudon Landfill. Customers have been notified individually by letter as to the increase they will be receiving.

Pricing initiatives are never easy, but they are necessary. By giving proper notice to our customer base, we are hopeful that the impact can be as minimal as possible.

Dear Mr. Haynes:

At the request of TDEC, Santek Environmental, LLC (Santek) has prepared this letter response to the TDEC monthly inspection that occurred on April 21, 2023. During the inspection, the observations below were made related to Facility operations. Below each observation, a response/status has been provided by Santek which shows corrective action for the subject items. In addition, a conference call was held between representatives of Santek, TDEC, and the Loudon County Solid Waste Disposal Commission on May 9, 2023 to discuss these corrective actions and provide the basis for this response.

Leachate Improperly Managed and Inadequate Maintenance of Leachate Management System/Leachate Observed at the Site

 TDEC observed several leachate outbreaks. TDEC noted that seeps have been worked on but said that further work is required which may involve alternative methodologies to get the seeps to drain properly.

Response/Corrective Action: 3rd party help was hired to assist. A solar-powered Blackhawk pump with a casing and river rock has been installed in the excavation of a lingering leachate seep on the East Slope to address this area. Pumped liquid is currently being facilitated into a nearby leachate collection system cleanout with a 2-inch HDPE pipe. Remaining seeps have been redirected into the landfill and properly covered.

Unsatisfactory Litter Control

- TDEC noted that flagging litter needs to be addressed immediately and that additional cover is required to cover exposed waste.
 - Response/Corrective Action: Additional help in the form of two temporary and one fulltime employee were hired for litter control/addressing cover. The temporary employees are addressing litter control and the full-time employee is aggressively addressing cover.

Inadequate Erosion Control

- TDEC observed several areas containing erosion damage and noted that they need to be addressed immediately.
 - Response/Corrective Action: Santek is actively in the process of addressing erosion. Seeding and temporary stabilization of slopes are currently underway per our stormwater management plan. A diversion berm has been installed on the Eastern slope and another diversion berm is currently being installed on the Western slope. Stormwater down drains are being installed to facilitate collected stormwater to sediment ponds. This work is expected to be complete by the end of May 2023.

Unsatisfactory Intermediate Cover

- TDEC said that flagging litter needs to be addressed immediately and requires more intermediate cover.
 - Response/Corrective Action: One full-time employee has been hired for addressing cover which has been addressed as of May 5, 2023.

Unsatisfactory Final Cover

- TDEC noted that trees/rooting plant located in the final cap closed area are very close to gas vents and need to be removed.
 - Response/Corrective Action: Routine vegetative maintenance was scheduled to address this area. This routine maintenance was conducted early than originally planned and the problematic area was addressed as of May 5, 2023.


